<p>PART C – GENERAL CONDITIONS</p> <p>C15 WARRANTY</p>	<p>Add C15.2 to read:</p> <p>If a defect or deficiency prevents the full and normal use or operation of the Work or any portion thereof, for purposes of calculating the warranty period, time shall be deemed to cease to elapse for the defective or deficient portion, and for any portion of the Work whose use or operation is prevented by such defect or deficiency, as of the date on which the defect or deficiency is observed or the use or operation is prevented and shall begin to run again when the defect or deficiency has been corrected or the Work may be used or operated to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.</p>
<p>PART C – GENERAL CONDITIONS</p> <p>C15 WARRANTY</p>	<p>Add C15.3 to read:</p> <p>If any law of Manitoba or of the jurisdiction in which the Work was manufactured requires, or if the manufacturer provides, a longer warranty period or a warranty which is more extensive in its nature, then the provisions of such law or manufacturer's warranty shall apply.</p>
